Method

1 You need a picture of poppies.

Elicit what the flower reminds the students of. In pairs, students think of different things the flower reminds them of.

2 Play the song "The Poppies blow" (YouTube)

Ask the students what the images are. (Soldiers, graves with crosses, hospitals with nurses and doctors, horses, pilots, factories fields with poppies, friends,..)

Elicit the topic (not the title) of the book they are going to read. (war)

Elicit what the students know about the First World War.

3 Pre-Reading Vocabulary – group activity, based on matching words with their definitions.

Copy and cut up the war words (A-cards) and their definitions (B-cards) one set for each group.

Divide the class into pairs or groups of three. Give each group a set of A-cards and B- cards.

Students match the cards.

Check orally with the whole class. Do it this way. Shuffle the definitions (B-cards) and read them



up one at a time. Ask different pairs/groups to give you the corresponding word.

4 A game - practicing the vocabulary from 3.

Use the set of the words (A-cards).

Divide the class into groups of 3-4. Give each group a set of A-cards. They shuffle them and place them face down on a pile in front of them. The first student picks up the top card, says it and then gives the definition. If correct, s/he keeps the card. If not, the card is placed at the bottom of the pile to be used later on. It is now next student's turn to pick up a card. The game continues in this way until all the cards are used up. The person with the most is the winner.
